NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING

2009 – WAVERLY ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT
(Between St. Joseph Avenue to north of Willow Street in Lansing Township)

The Board of Ingham County Road Commissioners will hold a public informational meeting on Monday, May 18, 2009 from 3:00p.m. – 6:00p.m. to provide citizens information on the upcoming Waverly Road project. The meeting will be held at the Lansing Charter Township Building, which is located at 3209 West Michigan Avenue, Lansing, Michigan 48917.

There will be no formal presentation made at any particular time, so residents may drop in at any time between 3:00pm to 6:00pm. Road Commission staff will be available throughout this time period to answer questions from citizens individually.

The Waverly Road project is expected to begin June 2009, and should be complete by the end of November 2009. This project involves milling off the old deteriorated surface and repaving it with new asphalt. It will also include widening the road for a center left turn lane at Willow Street, and signal improvements for better traffic flow. New water mains are also to be installed on the east side. During the project traffic will be maintained, but with various lane closures.

Any person wishing to present comments on the project is invited to be present; however, if a person wishing to present a written statement or an exhibit at the meeting cannot be present, he/she may convey that statement or exhibit to the Board of Ingham County Road Commissioners by addressing those comments to the Secretary to the Board and mailing it to 301 bush street, P.O. Box 38, Mason, Michigan 48854. Communications via e-mail will be accepted and can be sent to roads@inghamcrc.org.

The Ingham County Road Commission will provide necessary reasonable auxiliary aids and services, such as interpreters for the hearing impaired and audio tapes of printed materials being considered at the meeting for the visually impaired, for individuals with disabilities at the meeting upon five (5) working days notice to the Ingham County Road Commission.
